From Father Alejandro's Desk

Dear parishioners,

Last week we gave space to place the names of all those who celebrated their First Holy Communion on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. Let us keep them in our prayers, that they may persevere in their friendship with Jesus and grow in their desire to take on the future of our parish community.

From June 16-22, 5 youth and young adults from our community: Briselda, Kimberly, Brenda, Daniela and Marvin, will be in a week of formation for their personal development and to acquire leadership skills that will allow them, and us with them, to offer opportunities for accompaniment, evangelization and personal growth to our youth and young adults. Let us pray for them and for the present of our parish community: the youth.

Speaking of them, on June 23 we will celebrate the Confirmations of those who have been preparing for two years. There will be about 30, including youth and young adults. Let us also keep them in our prayers, so that the Holy Spirit may renew in them the desire to follow Jesus Christ and walk together as a community of faith among us.

As we continue with our reading from *Dignitas infinita*, on Human Dignity, the paragraph 30 speaks to us of freedom, the real one: "Freedom is a marvelous gift from God. Even when God draws us to him with his grace, he does so in a way that never violates our freedom. Thus, it would be a grave error to think that by distancing ourselves from God and his assistance, we could somehow be freer and thus feel more dignified. Instead, detached from the Creator, our freedom can only weaken and become obscured. The same happens if freedom imagines itself to be independent of any external reference and perceives any relationship with a prior truth as a threat; as a result, respect for the freedom and dignity of others would also diminish. As Pope Benedict XVI explained, "A will which believes itself radically incapable of seeking truth and goodness has no objective reasons or motives for acting save those imposed by its fleeting and contingent interests; it does not have an 'identity' to safeguard and build up through truly free and conscious decisions. As a result, it cannot demand respect from other 'wills,' which are themselves detached from their own deepest being and thus capable of imposing other 'reasons' or, for that matter, no 'reason' at all. The illusion that moral relativism provides the key for peaceful coexistence is actually the origin of divisions and the denial of the dignity of human beings."

Pope Francis' intention for the month of June is for the migrants fleeing their homes: "We pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys full of danger and violence, find welcome and new opportunities in the countries that receive them."

Queridos feligreses,

La semana pasada cedimos el espacio para colocar los nombres de todos los que celebraron su Primera Comunión en la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi. Tengámoslos en nuestras oraciones, para que perseveren en la amistad con Jesús y crezca en ellos el deseo de asumir el futuro de nuestra comunidad parroquial.

Entre el 16 al 22 de junio, 5 jóvenes de nuestra comunidad: Briselda, Kimberly, Brenda, Daniela y Marvin, estarán en una semana de formación para su desarrollo personal y para adquirir habilidades de liderazgo que les permita, y a nosotros con ellos, ofrecer oportunidades de acompañamiento, evangelización y crecimiento personal a nuestros jóvenes. Oremos por ellos y por el presente de nuestra comunidad parroquial: los jóvenes.

Hablando de ellos, el 23 de junio celebraremos las confirmaciones de aquellos que vienen preparándose durante dos años. Serán alrededor de 30, entre jóvenes y adultos. Tengámoslos también presentes a ellos en nuestras oraciones, para que el Espíritu Santo renueve en ellos el deseo de seguir a Jesucristo y caminar juntos como comunidad de fe.

Continuando con nuestra lectura de *Dignitas infinita*, sobre la dignidad humana, el párrafo 30 nos habla de la libertad, la auténtica: "La libertad es un don maravilloso de Dios. Incluso cuando nos atrae con su gracia, Dios lo hace de tal manera que nuestra libertad nunca se ve violentada. Por eso, sería un grave error pensar que, lejos de Dios y de su ayuda, podemos ser más libres y, en consecuencia, sentirnos más dignos. Desvinculada de su Creador, nuestra libertad sólo puede debilitarse y oscurecerse. Lo mismo ocurre si la libertad se imagina como independiente de cualquier referencia que no sea ella misma y se percibe como una amenaza cualquier relación con una verdad precedente. Como consecuencia, también fracasará el respeto por la libertad y la dignidad de los demás. Así lo explicó el Papa Benedicto XVI: «una voluntad que se cree radicalmente incapaz de buscar la verdad y el bien no tiene razones objetivas y motivos para obrar, sino aquellos que provienen de sus intereses momentáneos y pasajeros; no tiene una "identidad" que custodiar y construir a través de las opciones verdaderamente libres y conscientes. No puede, pues, reclamar el respeto por parte de otras "voluntades", que también están desconectadas de su ser más profundo, y que pueden hacer prevalecer otras "razones" o incluso ninguna "razón". La ilusión de encontrar en el relativismo moral la clave para una pacífica convivencia, es en realidad el origen de la división y negación de la dignidad de los seres humanos»."

La intención del Papa Francisco para el mes de junio es por los que huyen de su país: "Oremos para que los migrantes que huyen de las guerras o del hambre, obligados a viajes llenos de peligro y violencia, encuentren aceptación y nuevas oportunidades de vida en sus países de acogida."

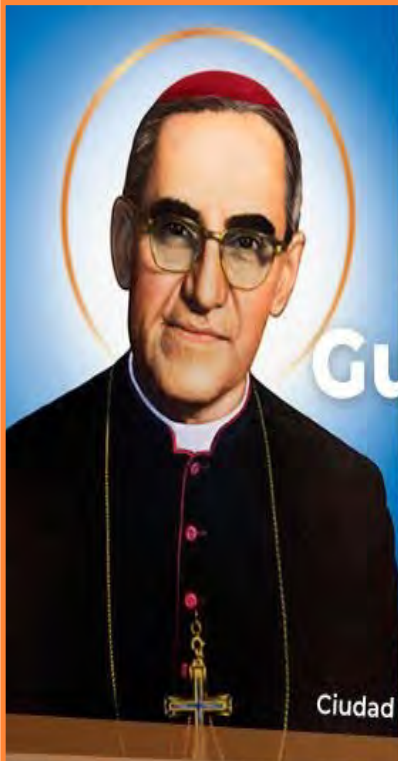

Small and Miraculous

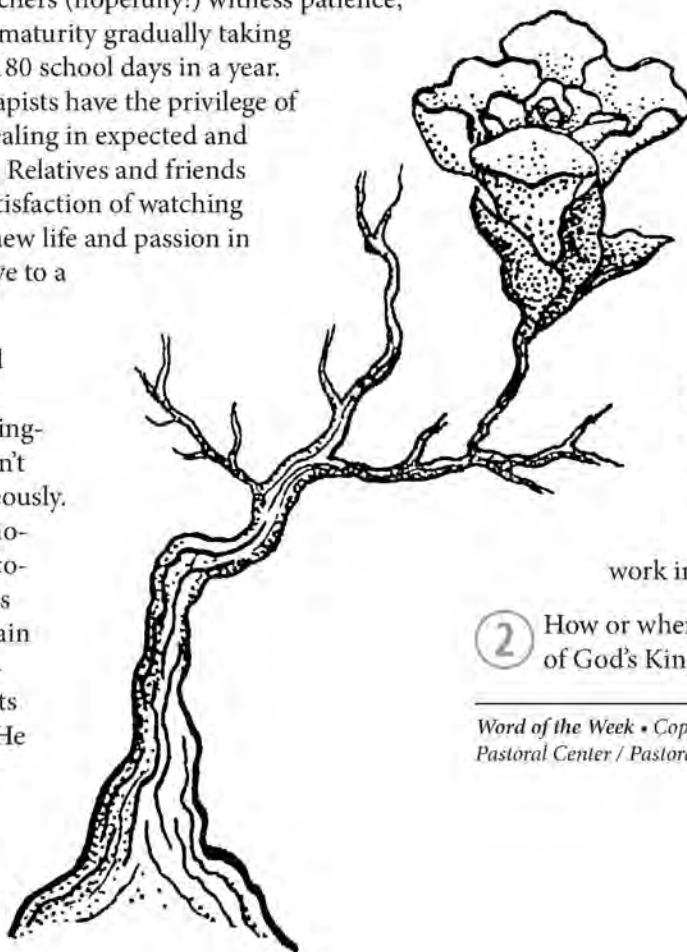
This Week's Readings at Mass

- ▶ Ezekiel 17:22-24 - Prophecy of the restoration of Israel
- ▶ 2 Corinthians 5:6-10 - Walking by faith
- ▶ Mark 4:26-34 - Seed grows by itself and the mustard seed

Both the first reading from Ezekiel and the Gospel reading point to God's power to turn small and seemingly insignificant things into works of great beauty, strength, and abundance. Ezekiel imagines this as God planting a tender shoot which becomes a majestic cedar tree. Jesus uses the image of the tiny mustard seed growing into a large plant that provides a haven for birds.

We don't have to be farmers or gardeners to experience how the Kingdom of God is slowly revealed. Parents have this experience when they conceive a child and are stunned by the miracle of their new baby at birth. Teachers (hopefully!) witness patience, compassion, and maturity gradually taking root throughout 180 school days in a year. Doctors and therapists have the privilege of seeing patients healing in expected and unexpected ways. Relatives and friends experience the satisfaction of watching a loved one find new life and passion in a courageous move to a second career.

As with seeds and plants, all growth takes time. The Kingdom of God doesn't appear instantaneously. Racism, sexism, homophobia, and economic inequalities still cause great pain and suffering. Because God respects human free will, He doesn't intervene and fix everything for us in a split second.

Pequeñas y milagros

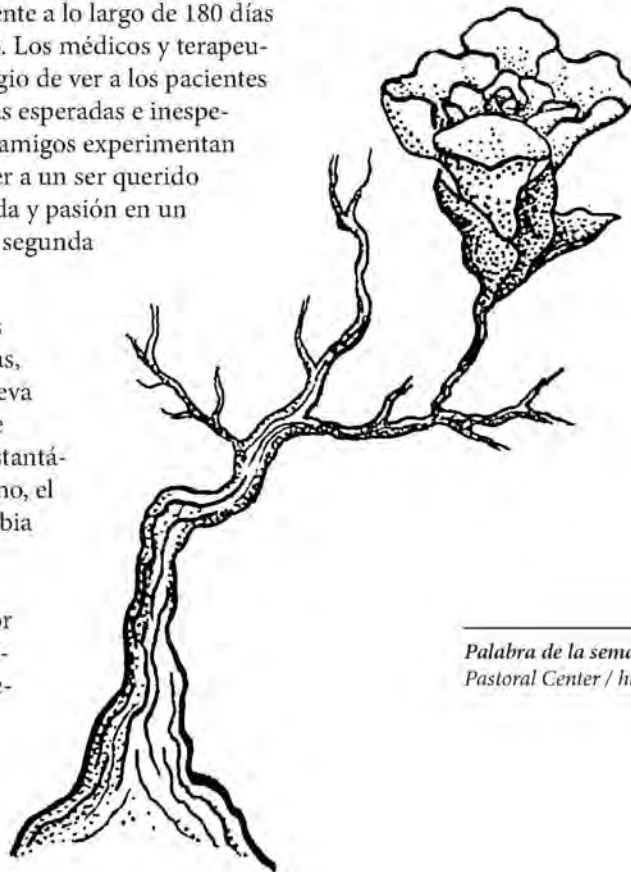
Las lecturas de esta semana en la misa

- ▶ Ezequiel 17:22-24 - La profecía de la restauración de Israel
- ▶ 2 Corintios 5:6-10 - Caminando por la fe
- ▶ Marcos 4:26-34 - La semilla crece por sí misma y la semilla de mostaza

Tanto la primera lectura de Ezequiel como la lectura del Evangelio apuntan al poder de Dios para convertir cosas pequeñas y aparentemente insignificantes en obras de gran belleza, fuerza y abundancia. Ezequiel imagina esto como Dios plantando un brote tierno que se convierte en un majestuoso árbol de cedro. Jesús utiliza la imagen de la pequeña semilla de mostaza que crece en una gran planta que proporciona un refugio para las aves.

No tenemos que ser agricultores o jardineros para experimentar cómo el Reino de Dios se revela lentamente. Los padres tienen esta experiencia cuando conciben un hijo y se quedan atónitos por el milagro de su nuevo bebé al nacer. Los maestros (¡con suerte!) son testigos de cómo la paciencia, la compasión y la madurez se arraigan gradualmente a lo largo de 180 días escolares en un año. Los médicos y terapeutas tienen el privilegio de ver a los pacientes sanando de maneras esperadas e inesperadas. Familiares y amigos experimentan la satisfacción de ver a un ser querido encontrar nueva vida y pasión en un valiente paso a una segunda carrera.

Al igual que con las semillas y las plantas, todo crecimiento lleva tiempo. El Reino de Dios no aparece instantáneamente. El racismo, el sexismo, la homofobia y las desigualdades económicas siguen causando gran dolor y sufrimiento. Debido a que Dios respeta la voluntad libre del ser humano, Él no interviene y arregla

todo para nosotros en una fracción de segundo. Lo que Dios hace es sorprendernos ayudando a la más pequeña de las semillas a crecer y florecer en el tiempo.
