From Father Alejandro's Desk

Dear parishioners,

We thank God for the 31 new confirmands who today, through the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation, are sealed by the Holy Spirit. Let us pray that the gifts they receive may bear fruit in them and that they may be courageous witnesses of the Gospel among young people, family members and co-workers. Let us also pray for their parents and godparents, that they may be willing to continue accompanying their children and godchildren in their journey of faith and that this accompaniment may serve parents and godparents to persevere in the Christian vocation they have received at baptism.

We also welcome Briselda, Kimberly, Brenda, Daniela and Marvin, who spent the past week in a formation meeting for their personal development and to acquire leadership skills that will allow them to offer opportunities for accompaniment, evangelization and personal growth to our young people. Let us pray for them and for the present of our parish community: the youth.

Last week, in our reading of *Dignitas infinita*, on human dignity, we shared paragraph 30 dedicated to speaking of authentic freedom. Continuing the reflection, in paragraph 31 we find: "Moreover, it would be unrealistic to posit an abstract freedom devoid of any influence, context, or limitation. Instead, "the proper exercise of personal freedom requires specific conditions of an economic, social, juridic, political and cultural order," which often remain unfulfilled. In this sense, we can say that some individuals enjoy more "freedom" than others. Pope Francis has given special attention to this point: "Some people are born into economically stable families, receive a fine education, grow up well nourished, or naturally possess great talent. They will certainly not need a proactive state; they need only claim their freedom. Yet, the same rule clearly does not apply to a disabled person, to someone born in dire poverty, to those lacking a good education and with little access to adequate health care. If a society is governed primarily by the criteria of market freedom and efficiency, there is no place for such persons, and fraternity will remain just another vague ideal." Therefore, it is crucial to understand that "removing injustices promotes human freedom and dignity" at every level of human endeavor. To enable authentic freedom, "we must put human dignity back at the center and, on that pillar, build the alternative social structures we need." Similarly, freedom is frequently obscured by a variety of psychological, historical, social, educational, and cultural influences. Real and historical freedom always needs to be "liberated." One must, moreover, reaffirm the fundamental right to religious freedom.

Queridos feligreses,

Damos gracias a Dios por los nuevos 31 confirmandos que hoy, a través de la celebración del sacramento de la Confirmación, son sellados por el Espíritu Santo. Oremos para que los dones que reciben fructifiquen en ellos y sean testigos valientes del evangelio entre los jóvenes, familiares y compañeros de trabajo. Oremos también por sus padres y padrinos, para que estén dispuestos a continuar el acompañamiento en la jornada de fe de sus hijos y ahijados y que ese acompañamiento les sirva a padres y padrinos para perseverar en la vocación cristiana que han recibido en el bautismo.

Damos la bienvenida también a Briselda, Kimberly, Brenda, Daniela y Marvin, quienes estuvieron la semana que pasó en un encuentro de formación para su desarrollo personal y para adquirir habilidades de liderazgo que les permitirá ofrecer oportunidades de acompañamiento, evangelización y crecimiento personal a nuestros jóvenes. Oremos por ellos y por el presente de nuestra comunidad parroquial: los jóvenes.

La semana pasada, en nuestra lectura de *Dignitas infinita*, sobre la dignidad humana, compartíamos el párrafo 30 dedicado a hablar de la auténtica libertad. Siguiendo la reflexión, en el párrafo 31 encontramos: "Además, no sería realista afirmar una libertad abstracta, libre de cualquier condicionamiento, contexto o límite. Por el contrario, «el recto ejercicio de la libertad personal exige unas determinadas condiciones de orden económico, social, jurídico, político y cultural»^[48], que a menudo no se cumplen. En este sentido, podemos decir que unos son más "libres" que otros. El Papa Francisco se ha detenido especialmente en este punto: «algunos nacen en familias de buena posición económica, reciben buena educación, crecen bien alimentados, o poseen naturalmente capacidades destacadas. Ellos seguramente no necesitarán un Estado activo y sólo reclamarán libertad. Pero evidentemente no cabe la misma regla para una persona con discapacidad, para alguien que nació en un hogar extremadamente pobre, para alguien que creció con una educación de baja calidad y con escasas posibilidades de curar adecuadamente sus enfermedades. Si la sociedad se rige primariamente por los criterios de la libertad de mercado y de la eficiencia, no hay lugar para ellos, y la fraternidad será una expresión romántica más». Por lo tanto, es indispensable comprender que «la liberación de las injusticias promueve la libertad y la dignidad humana» en todos los niveles y relaciones de las acciones humanas. Para que sea posible una auténtica libertad «tenemos que volver a llevar la dignidad humana al centro y que sobre ese pilar se construyan las estructuras sociales alternativas que necesitamos». Análogamente, la libertad se ve frecuentemente oscurecida por numerosos condicionamientos psicológicos, históricos, sociales, educativos y culturales. La libertad real e histórica siempre necesita ser "liberada". Y se deberá, también, reaffirmar el derecho fundamental a la libertad religiosa."

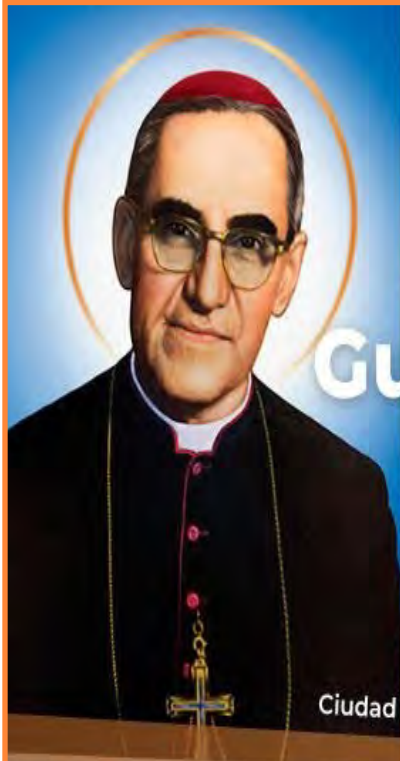

Calm During the Storm

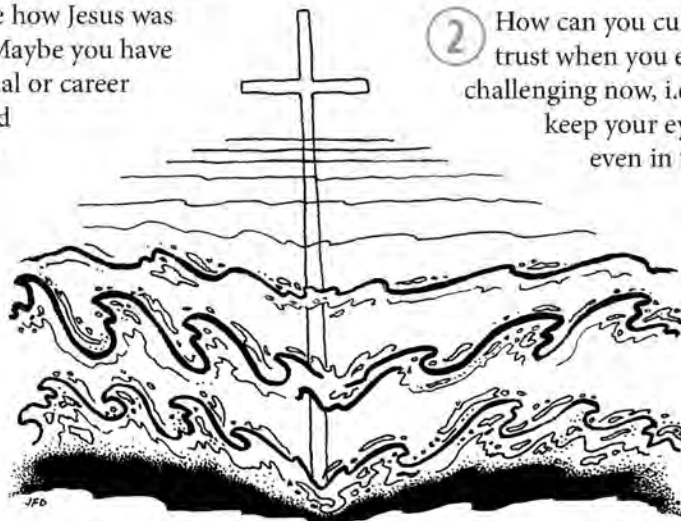
This Week's Readings at Mass

- ▶ Job 38:1, 8-11 - The Lord's speech to Job
- ▶ 2 Corinthians 5:14-17 - The ministry of reconciliation
- ▶ Mark 4:35-41 - The storm on the sea

The first reading and the Psalm response for the day (Ps 107:23-31) testify to God's power over nature, in this case, the sea. In biblical times, the sea represented the forces of chaos. God tells Job in no uncertain terms that God is in charge of the sea - God sets its boundaries, and the sea obeys his commands. The Psalm relates an account of sailors who experienced God's saving power when they cried out to him during a storm on the sea, and God responded by calming the storm. When Jesus ordered the wind to be still, those in the boat with him would have made the connection between Jesus calming the storm and God calming storms in earlier Bible stories.

Most of us can probably relate to the disciples who fear for their lives when they are in the midst of the storm on the sea. There is a great windstorm going on, and the waves are swamping the boat. Who wouldn't be afraid? Apparently, not Jesus, who is so calm that the disciples find it hard to believe that he could sleep through the danger.

Looking back on our lives, we can probably identify storms we have lived through that ended with safety and peace. Maybe as a mother, you have agonized about your child's physical or mental health crisis, and now you can see how Jesus was with you the whole time. Maybe you have come through a professional or career crisis that you feared would swamp you, but you made it safely to another shore. Or perhaps you've endured the death of a loved one which you thought couldn't survive, but somehow you have come to find peace despite the loss.

Sheepish Question:
When have the forces of nature challenged my faith in God's power?

Perhaps the invitation in this passage is to recognize, like the disciples, that we will live through storms. Just because we follow Jesus doesn't mean things will be easy. Yet we can choose between reacting in fear and panic, or looking to Jesus in trust and asking that he help us keep a calm head during the storm.

Questions of the Week

- ① When have you experienced a turbulent time but realized that Jesus brought you safely to the other side?
- ② How can you cultivate a greater sense of trust when you experience something challenging now, i.e., what can you do to keep your eyes on Jesus who is calm even in the midst of a storm?

Calma durante la tormenta

Las lecturas de esta semana en la misa

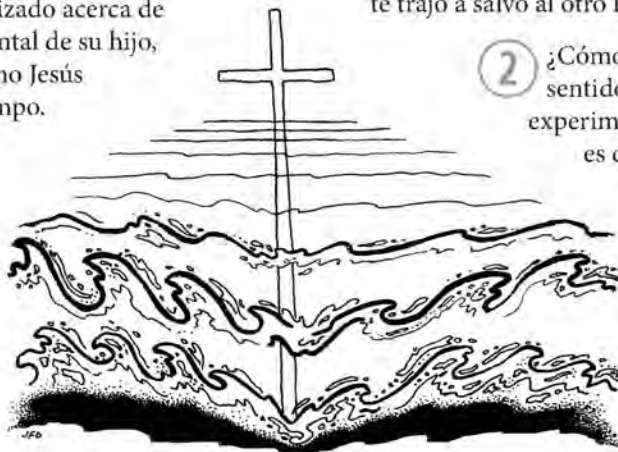
- ▶ Job 38:1, 8-11 - El discurso del Señor a Job
- ▶ 2 Corintios 5:14-17 - El ministerio de reconciliación
- ▶ Marcos 4:35-41 - La tormenta en el mar

La primera lectura y la respuesta del Salmo para el día (Salmos 107:23-31) testifican del poder de Dios sobre la naturaleza, en este caso, el mar. En los tiempos bíblicos, el mar representaba las fuerzas del caos. Dios le dice a Job en términos inequívocos que Dios está a cargo del mar - Dios establece sus límites, y el mar obedece sus mandamientos. El Salmo relata un relato de marineros que experimentaron el poder salvador de Dios cuando le clamaron durante una tormenta en el mar, y Dios respondió calmando la tormenta. Cuando Jesús ordenó que el viento estuviera quieto, aquellos en el barco con él habrían hecho la conexión entre Jesús calmando la tormenta y Dios calmando las tormentas en historias bíblicas anteriores.

La mayoría de nosotros probablemente podemos relacionarnos con los discípulos que temen por sus vidas cuando están en medio de la tormenta en el mar. Hay una gran tormenta de viento en marcha, y las olas están inundando el barco. ¿Quién no tendría miedo? Aparentemente, Jesús no, que está tan tranquilo que a los discípulos les cuesta creer que pudiera dormir a través del peligro.

Mirando hacia atrás en nuestras vidas, probablemente podamos identificar tormentas que hemos vivido que terminaron con seguridad y paz. Tal vez como madre, usted ha agonizado acerca de la crisis de salud física o mental de su hijo, y ahora usted puede ver cómo Jesús estaba con usted todo el tiempo.

Tal vez hayas pasado por una crisis profesional o profesional que temías que te inundaría, pero llegaste a salvo a otra orilla. O tal vez has soportado la muerte de un ser querido que pensabas que no podía sobrevivir, pero de



Pregunta:

¿En qué ocasiones las fuerzas de la naturaleza han desafiado mi fe en el poder de Dios?

alguna manera has llegado a encontrar la paz a pesar de la pérdida.

Tal vez la invitación en este pasaje es reconocer, como los discípulos, que viviremos a través de las tormentas. El hecho de que sigamos a Jesús no significa que las cosas serán fáciles. Sin embargo, podemos elegir entre reaccionar con miedo y pánico, o mirar a Jesús en confianza y pedirle que nos ayude a mantener una cabeza tranquila durante la tormenta.

Preguntas de la semana

- 1 ¿Cuándo has experimentado un tiempo turbulento, pero te has dado cuenta de que Jesús te trajo a salvo al otro lado?
- 2 ¿Cómo puedes cultivar un mayor sentido de confianza cuando experimentas algo desafiante ahora, es decir, ¿qué puedes hacer para mantener tus ojos en Jesús que está tranquilo incluso en medio de una tormenta?
